## Kanatai Gets Hip Fixed with HPAN's Sponsorship of \$500



Kanatai's owners surrendered him to the shelter when they could not afford to have his hip injury repaired. The shelter was unable to expend the resources to help him, which meant he had a very little chance of survival until the Blount County Animal Welfare Society stepped in. They worked with a local veterinarian who was willing to give a major discount on the surgery. HPAN's sponsorship of \$500 covered the majority of the cost, and Kanatai was later transported up north for a second chance at life!

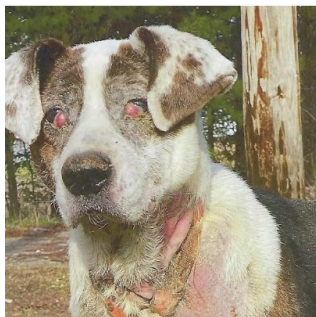

# Rescue Spotlight 🐾

## Spay It Forward East TN

Spay It Forward East TN's mission is to improve the lives of animals and the people who love them. This rescue makes a difference in the community by offering assistance with spay/neuter, pet food, dog houses, training resources, crates, and more. The rescue's goal is to keep pets with their people; but if retention is not an option, then they focus on rescue.

*"Working to improve the lives of animals  
and the people who love them"*

Spay It Forward's primary goal is to spay/neuter and vaccinate as many animals as financially possible. With appropriate funding, they are able to offer reduced and free spay/neuter to pet owners. TNVR – Trap Neuter Vaccinate Return - is another major initiative of the rescue. Many cats are typically euthanized on intake at local shelters since the area is heavily populated with stray, feral, and free roaming cats. The rescue offers assistance with trapping and spaying/neutering these cats to end breeding. On average the rescue is able to spay/neuter 30-40 stray/feral/free roaming cats every month with the help of their donors. Spay It Forward is also able to rescue sick, starving, and broken animals, thanks to the support of their donors. These animals are restored to health, and under the rescue's care, they are spayed/neutered, vaccinated, and microchipped before finding their forever families.



Spay It Forward has TNR'd over 1,200 stray cats in Anderson and surrounding counties. They have facilitated 578 spay/neuter surgeries for owned pets, and hundreds of animals have been rescued from abusive situations, neglect, and abandonment. To date, the rescue has helped over 300 pets stay with their owners by providing food, vet care, flea treatments, spay/neuter assistance, and education.
