Treasury Notes

This fiscal year (which ends on July 31) we have: paid \$41,919.22 in vet bills for 257 rescue animals and raised \$59,304.25.

Here are a few we've helped...

Ten Dogs Get HPAN Help with \$2,214.75 in Paid Vet Services

Two of these babies were shelter strays and the rest were from a hoarding situation. All of them were in dire need of rescue, so the Humane Society of Roane County stepped in to help. We had the opportunity to sponsor their basic and not so basic vet services. All of the dogs will travel to a north-based rescue. We wish these little ones happy trails!



BluBelle and Chevy Get HPAN's Help with \$539

Almost Home Animal Rescue took these two dogs into their program and asked us to help with some needed vetting. Chevy's owner became ill and had to be placed in hospice care, so he needed a new home, and BluBelle was surrendered to rescue after being used for breeding. We covered the costs of exams, vaccines, parasite testing/medications, x-rays, and spay/neuter. Here's to hoping both of these beauties are adopted into forever loving homes very soon!



Seven Kittens Vetted with \$390 from HPAN



From making it off the streets to making it out of the shelter, these seven are now with Almost Home Animal Rescue. We had the opportunity to cover their initial vetting (exams, vaccines, deworm, combo testing, etc.) for \$390.
